

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entries

1. Entrants must be residents of Litchfield Municipality.
2. Entries may be visual art, sculpture, textile, photography, craft in any medium.
3. Entries should be guided by the theme 'Community'.
4. Entries must have been completed in the 12 months before Friday the 10th March 2023.
5. Entries must be the original and unassisted work of the Entrant, not be copies of other peoples' work.
6. Entries must not be offensive, libelous or in breach of copyright or moral rights.
7. Entries may comprise a group or set of small items.
8. Entries must be ready to hang or display.
9. Hanging works must not exceed 10kg. Sculpture must be a maximum of 10kg and safe and easy to move.
10. Entries must not have been publicly exhibited previously at a Litchfield Council event.
11. Entries must be marked with the title, Entrant's name and contact details.
12. One Entry form per entry, up to 2 entries per person, \$15/20 per entry.
13. The entry fee is to be paid through the link on the Entry form or by credit card at Council's office at 7 Bees Creek Road, Freds Pass.
14. Completed entry forms and payment of entry must be received on or before 19 February 2023.

Delivery, Insurance and Collection

15. Entries must be delivered to the exhibition venue between 9.00am and 7.00pm on Tuesday 7th March 2023.
16. Each Entry must have the artists name and title of the work.
17. The Council will cover Entries by appropriate insurance whilst in Council's custody between delivery on Tuesday 7th March 2023 and 4.00pm Monday 13 March 2023.
18. All Entries must be collected from the exhibition venue between 3.00pm and 5.00pm on Sunday 12th March or 10.00am and 2.00pm Monday 13 March 2022.
19. The Entrant is responsible delivery, collection and any packing, freight costs and transit insurance.

Sales

20. Sales will be managed by Darwin Community Arts with a 10% administration fee additional to the artists price. If an artist wants their work to be sold all bank account details will need to be included in the registration form.
21. Sold Entries must not be removed from the exhibition venue until the end of the exhibition

Awards

22. Awards will be determined by a panel of judges whose decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
23. The Judged Awards and any Sponsored Awards will be announced at the Public Launch 10th March
24. Awards are non-acquisitive
25. Last year's winners can opt out of judging
26. The Community's Choice Award will be determined by ballot during the public exhibition, with voting allowed only by persons attending the exhibition. The award will be announced on the Litchfield Council Facebook page following the exhibition.

Other

27. Entrants agree to artworks being photographed and reproduced (free of charge but with appropriate attribution) to promote or record this or future Litchfield Art Exhibitions and for images of the Exhibition where artworks are visible to be used in any Litchfield Council publications, marketing and promotions. Photographs will be taken at the event of art works and the public.
28. Artworks cannot include animals, dead or alive
29. Council will consider all entries, but reserves the right not to exhibit any entry
